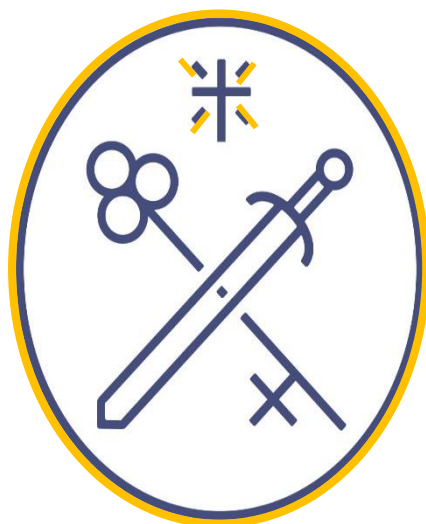

The statement was written by the Headteacher in March 2016 and will be reviewed annually unless there is a change in legislation (current legislation: The School Information (England) (Amendment) Regulations 2012: S1 2012/1124)

St Peter and St Paul Catholic Primary’s website www.stpetersandstpauls.islington.sch.uk provides a range of statutory information about the school as well as providing up to date information for parents and members of the community about school life. From September 2012 regulations no longer require our school to publish a prospectus or have a curriculum policy. Instead, we are required to publish key information online. This will be: the school’s Pupil Premium allocation, its use and impact on attainment; its curriculum by year and by subject; its admission arrangements; its policies on behaviour, charging, and SEN and disability; links to Ofsted reports; and details of, and links to, performance data.
