Pupil Premium Activities and Intervention Programmes

We are now required by the D.F.E (Department for Education) to publish where we spend the pupil premium money at St Peter and St Paul RC Primary School. This is the money we are given to help all children make progress and learn and is based on the number of children who are entitled to free school meals. At St Peter and St Paul a number of families are entitled to this, although all children in Islington currently receive a free school meal.

Below is a range of activities and intervention programmes that take place at St Peter and St Paul School:

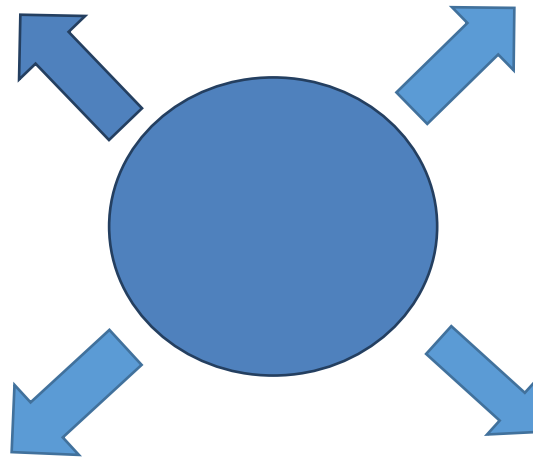
Delegated Pupil Premium funding for 2013/14 Financial Year £106,200

This includes the following interventions:

Group activities, catch up activities and 1 to 1 support

Wider opportunities:

- For support for outings and trips in all classes £3,000
- For support for school sports days £1,000
- For support for School Journey for KS2 Pupils £5,400
- Books for pupils to provide challenge and support £5,000
- After School Clubs: Music and Sport £5,000
