Attendance

SS. Peter & Paul School follows Islington guidelines regarding authorised and unauthorised absence. We request that all absences are reported to the office by 9.30am. If a child is not reported absent then the office will contact the family. On the day your child returns, a written letter should also be brought in explaining the absence.

Punctuality

It is very important that children are brought to school on time for the start of the school day as being late can be distressing for your child, and cause disruption for the class.

The school gates are opened at 8.45am. Once the gates are locked at 9.00am the children must come in via the main school entrance and will be marked as late. If your child is late, they will be given a late card, which must be given to their class teacher. Parents/ carers are responsible for signing their child's name in the late book.

It is school policy that ALL pupils should be accompanied by a responsible adult to school and supervised on school premises when the gates are opened at 8.45am. Staff will be on duty from 8.45am. Nursery and Reception classes will open their doors at 8.50am so they can be dropped off and to allow those with siblings to be taken to the junior playground. Please do not leave your children unattended until you see a member of staff on duty. Once the bells are rung please leave school premises promptly.



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No pupils, under any circumstances, may leave school premises. The younger pupils MUST STAY with their parent or carer and should NOT BE LEFT IN SCHOOL UNATTENDED.

ALL pupils must be collected after school. As always the wellbeing, health and safety of all pupils are of the utmost importance.
