In Summer 1, our History topic is 'Sensational Saxons'. We will be learning about the Roman withdrawal in Britain and Saxon life.



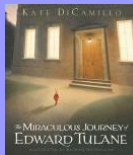
In Summer 2, our Geography topic is 'All the World is a Kitchen'. We will be learning about fair trade food and the distribution of the world natural resources.

We will be thinking about how the texts relate to the larger world and revising all of the English skills learnt in Year 4.

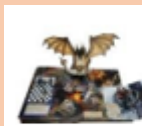
This spring term in Art and DT, we will be studying textiles and in Summer 2, modelling.
