Class assembly: **Thursday 23rd October 2025**

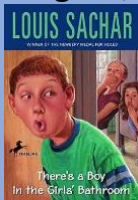
Swimming: **Monday 15th September** for two weeks.

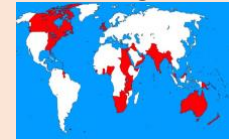
