We try to be kind, helpful and treat everyone as Jesus taught us.

☆ **Our School Rules**

These three rules help everyone learn and feel safe:

1. Be READY

- Come to school on time
- Have the right uniform and equipment
- Listen carefully in lessons
- Try your best

2. Be RESPECTFUL

- Be kind with your words and actions
- Listen to adults and each other
- Look after school property
- Follow our school values: *Love, Truth, Forgiveness, Giving, Understanding*

3. Be SAFE

- Walk in school
- Keep hands and feet to yourself
- Use equipment properly
- Ask for help when you need it

✨ **When You Make Good Choices**

Adults will notice and celebrate your good behaviour. You might get:

- Praise from an adult
- Stickers
- House Points (crystals)
- Dojo points
- Praise postcards
- Headteacher certificates
- Hot Chocolate Friday!

⚠ **When You Make a Poor Choice**

The adults will help you get back on track. They will always speak to you calmly and kindly. You might:

- Get a reminder
- Have some thinking time
- Miss a short part of playtime
- Work in another classroom
- Talk with a teacher or senior leader about how to make things better

Your teacher may also talk to your grown-ups at home to help you

Serious Behaviour

Sometimes behaviour is more serious, such as:

- Hurting someone
- Bullying or using unkind language
- Breaking things on purpose
- Refusing to follow instructions
- Saying discriminatory or unkind comments

If this happens, adults will:

- Talk to you and find out what happened
- Help you understand how to fix things
- Speak to your grown-ups
- Give a bigger consequence like missing playtime or working away from class

If the behaviour is very serious or happens again and again, the headteacher may decide other actions are needed.

Making Things Right (Restorative Conversations)

Adults will help you think about:

- What happened
- How you were feeling
- How others felt
- What you could do next time
- How you can put things right

Everyone gets a **fresh start every day**.

We Are All Part of Our School Family

- **Children:** follow the school rules
- **Adults:** help you learn, stay safe and make good choices
- **Parents and carers:** work with us to support you
